


Economic Development

Gap Financing To Businesses

Designed to provide gap financing for business and industry starting up or expanding in the five-county region The primary focus of the program is manufacturing and industrial-related businesses that will create or retain jobs.



Transportation

The UMVRDC has a planning assistance contract with the Minnesota Department of Transportation to provide assistance, information and technical support for transportation issues in the region.
