
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## Minnesota's September Employment Situation

- The unemployment rate held steady at 3.1%
  - The labor force size increased by 1,516 people over the month. The number of employed increased by 708 workers, and the number of unemployed increased by 808 people
- The labor force participation rate stayed the same overthe-month at 68.5%
- Minnesota's labor force is still 14k workers smaller than in Feb 2020
- Avg hourly wages for private sector workers are up 3.3% OTY and 13.6% since August 2020
  - Inflation was 3.7% OTY and 18.3% over the last three




#### EDR 6W- Upper Minnesota Valley 1st Quarter Change, 2020- to- 2023







Number of Job Vacancies 📰





found the student population at SCSU has dropped by almost 50 percent since 2010.





Minnesota's Share of Job Openings Requiring High School Diploma or Less




Percent of Job Openings







## CTE is a successful local workforce retention strategy






\* This figure represents students who took at least one CTE course in high school. Individuals with an employment record in Minnesota but unknown geographic location were excluded.

The likelihood of remaining in the same region for work among CTE participants who took work-based learning (blue bars) is even larger among students who completed apprenticeships or on-the-job training, which represent real job placement experiences for students. Table 2 shows how three Greater Minnesota regions – Northwest, Southwest, and Southeast – are on the forefront of offering exposure to real-world workplaces to Minnesota students through CTE.


#### 2023 Southwest Career Expo Results What type of job are you MOST interested in?








#### SW Career Expo How would you prefer to learn about careers?

#### 2023 Southwest Career Expo Where Do You Want To Live?






